About the Orissa Chemical Society

The Orissa Chemical Society was constituted in 1985 under the leadership of Prof. Mahendra Kumar Rout, renowned Professor of Chemistry of international repute and an educational administrator. The aims and objectives of the Society are to (i) promote and improve the standards of chemistry teaching in Odisha, (ii) promote research in chemistry and allied sciences in Odisha, (iii) organize conference and symposia to improve teaching and research in chemistry, (iv) popularize chemistry discipline and to create public awareness regarding environmental impacts of the use of various chemicals/chemical products in our daily life, (v) honor the eminent teachers and the chemists of Odisha and (vi) bring out a journal in chemistry, to spread creativity among young scholars. More than 1500 chemists are the Life and Patron Members of the Society. The OCS organizes Annual, Regional Conferences, OCS Extended Lecture Series, and OCS-Industry Interface Meet each year and offers many awards to the young chemists for their achievements in chemistry.

About the University

The Maharaja Sriram Chandra Bhanja Deo University (Erstwhile North Orissa University) was established in the year 1998 to cater the educational needs of the people of Northern Odisha. The University has two campuses (i) Main Campus at Baripada, Mayurbhanj and (ii) Second Campus at Keonjhar. The University has 103 affiliated colleges (Mayurbhanj - 65, Keonjhar - 38) including three autonomous colleges, two law colleges, and a medical college. At present the University offers various academic programmes under 22 Post-Graduate Departments in the Main Campus and 5 Post-Graduate Departments in the Second Campus. The University aims at acting as a beacon to this region for the upliftment of the tribal population.

About the Department

Department of Chemistry came into existence in 2004 with the objective of boosting scientific temper among the students. The Department has been supported by UGC SAP and DST-FIST during 2009-2014. Currently, the Department has also availed the assistance of Rs. 83 lakhs under DST-FIST programme (2019-2024). The Department has an enrolment of 30 M.Sc. and 10 M.Phil. students along with about 20 Ph.D. scholars. Several projects have been completed and some projects (funded by DST) are ongoing in the Department. The Department is well equipped with various equipments like XRD, FTIR, TG-DTA, AAS, DLS, UV-Vis DRS, GC and Surface Area Analyzer. The alumni of this department are now pursuing their research at most of the IITs of the country and other National Institutes like NISER, IISER and NITs. etc. and in abroad.

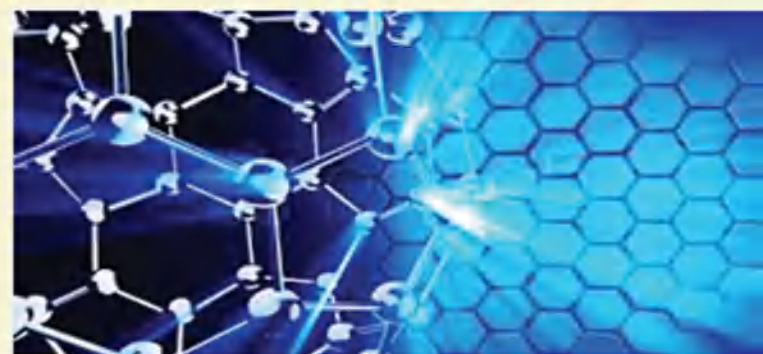
