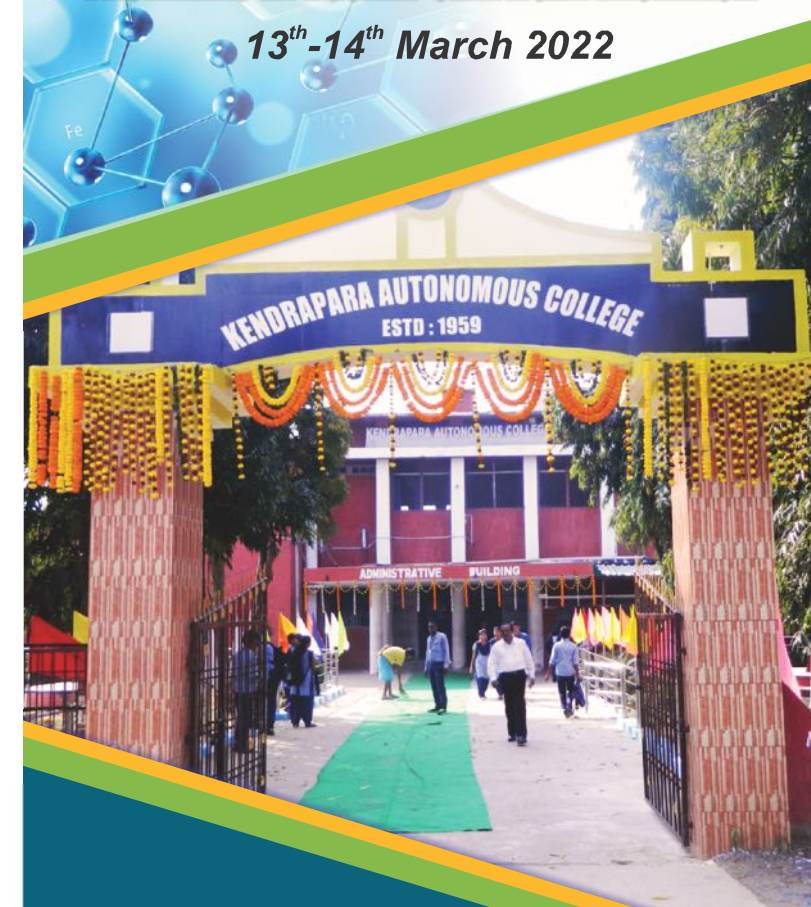

About Orissa Chemical Society

The Orissa Chemical Society was constituted in 1985 under the vibrant leadership of Late Prof. Mahendra Kumar Rout, renowned Professor of Chemistry of International repute and an educational administrator. The aim and objective of the Society are to (i) Promote and improve the standard of teaching of chemistry in the state (ii) Promote research in chemistry and allied science in the state (iii) Organize conferences and symposia in furtherance of knowledge in chemistry (iv) Popularize the discipline chemistry and to create public awareness regarding environmental impacts of the use of various chemicals/chemical products in our daily life (v) Honour the eminent teachers, and the chemists of Odisha (vi) Bring out a journal in chemistry which will spread the creativity among young scholars.

About Kendrapara Autonomous College

Kendrapara Autonomous College, the largest non-government college in the state, was founded on 12th February 1959 by late Dr. H.K. Mahatab, the then Chief Minister of Odisha. Within 63 years of its existence, the college has made significant growth, now with 5000 students, 70 teachers, and 67 non-teaching staff members. The college extends over 88 acres of land with impressive buildings, laboratories, a library, playfield, staff quarters, and hostels, giving visitors the impression of a mini university. The institution has expanded in all possible directions providing teaching facilities in Arts, Science, and Commerce streams up to degree levels with 22 Honours subjects and PG in Sociology. The college has attained autonomy since 2006 and was accredited with "A" grade by NAAC in 2006 and again in 2016.

About the Department of Chemistry

The genesis of this Department dates to 1962. After a lapse of 08 years, in the year 1970, this Department was upgraded

to degree level. Subsequently, in 1972, Honours teaching was started with 16 students. Despite ups and downs in its strides, this Department has marched ahead towards excellence in chemistry education at the degree level in the state, with six faculty members at present.

Theme of the Seminar

Materials of diverse kinds strongly govern the existence of living beings on this planet. Materials science dealing with materials and their transformations is inherently associated with Chemistry. All materials we use daily, like food, cloth, medicine, fuel, fertilizer, cosmetics, etc. result from Chemistry. It is impossible to imagine an advanced, comfortable and healthy life without advances in Chemistry. A greater understanding of the subject in cutting-edge research would help in developing novel material and technology to solve various global problems associated with food, water, health, energy & transportation etc.

The Department of Chemistry of Kendrapara Autonomous College, Kendrapara is organizing a National Seminar on "Frontiers in Recent Chemical Research" to create interest and enthusiasm in young people for innovative research. The seminar aims to address diverse aspects of chemistry. Emerging areas of chemical research in organic synthesis, nanochemistry, pharmaceutical chemistry (drug design and discovery), organometallic chemistry (catalysis), supramolecular chemistry, green chemistry, environmental chemistry, and photochemistry (study of the photochemical phenomenon), etc., will be deliberated.
