Prof. (Dr.) Ellarani Pattanaik, a loving and affectionate chemistry teacher, a Life Member of Orissa Chemical Society and Ravenshaw Chemistry Alumni Association, untimely passed away on the 16<sup>th</sup> March 2024 at Bhubaneswar. With her affectionate, amicable and soft nature, she endeared her colleagues and friends.

Prof. Pattanaik did her B.Sc., M.Sc. and Ph.D. from Utkal University. Her illustrious career spanned over 33 years. She retired as the Professor and Head of the Post Graduate Department of Chemistry, Khallikote Unitary University, Berhampur on 31st August 2023.

She was conferred Prof. P. L. Ramachandra Award in 1989 for Best Paper published in the Journal of Electro-Chemical Society of India. In 2002, she stood first from among the 94 selected OES (CB) Teachers in Chemistry to serve Government Autonomous Colleges. Her untimely demise has deeply shocked the Chemistry fraternity.
